## Carbon Emissions Statement

### Statement

We are committed to reducing our Carbon Impact and are currently working within the Airports Council International (ACI) Europe Airport Carbon Accreditation program. The management of our carbon emissions is a long-term commitment by Perth Airport and supports our views of sustainability and effective environmental management. This statement represents our commitment towards continual improvement and emissions reduction.

### Airport Carbon Accreditation

This is the only institutionally endorsed, carbon management certification standard for airports. It is a program with four levels, mapping a process for airports to becoming cleaner and more efficient, starting with having a carbon footprint independently verified in accordance with ISO14064 (Greenhouse Gas Accounting). The aim is to continually review and invest in ways to reduce our carbon emissions, and work with and influence others on the airport estate to also reduce their emissions.

### Our Commitments

Continual improvement in sustainability is integral to the way we do business. We are working towards reducing our carbon footprint by implementing initiatives to save energy and increase efficiency, with the overarching objective of reducing our greenhouse gas emissions. To this end, we are committed to:

- Meet legal requirements, and operate and achieve beyond minimum standards where practicable;
- Continue to prepare and present detailed inventories of our greenhouse gas emissions, which can inform our management actions;
- The reduction of PAPL only Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions to be carbon neutral by 2030;
- The use of 50% renewable energy across the airport estate by 2030;
- Work with tenants and partners to assist them in achieving sustainable working environments and supporting their sustainability innovations; and
- Achieve ACA Level 4 accreditation by 2026.
